In accordance with the principles of the Official Information Act, I seek to understand the transparency and competitiveness of the procurement process.

Please provide the names of the companies, agencies, or individuals that received payment for providing PR and Communications services to the MT. Additionally, I request the value of the contracts awarded to each service provider.

The objective of this request is to gain a comprehensive understanding of the MT investment in PR and Communications support, the processes by which these services are procured, and the entities that are engaged in providing these services."
