# **NELSON AIRPORT LIMITED: KIWI SHAREHOLDER**

#### PURPOSE

Advise you of the steps necessary for you, in your role as Minister of Transport, to take over the rights and responsibilities of the Kiwi Shareholder in Nelson Airport Limited.

#### Key points

- The Kiwi Share is a single redeemable preference share issued by Nelson Airport to the Crown.
- It confers certain rights and responsibilities on the holder. Its primary intent is to require the consent of the Kiwi Shareholder before certain land acquisitions can be made.
- At present, the Kiwi Share is not assigned.

### Recommendations

We recommend you:

1 sign the attached letter to the Prime Minister which proposes that you be the person entitled to exercise the rights and powers of the Kiwi Shareholder in accordance with Article 3.1 of the First Schedule to the constitution of Nelson Airport Limited

# **NELSON AIRPORT LIMITED: KIWI SHAREHOLDER**

#### The Kiwi Share pertains to certain land acquisitions

- 1 The Kiwi Share is a single redeemable preference share issued by Nelson Airport to the Crown. It confers certain rights and responsibilities on the holder. The primary intent is to require the consent of the Kiwi Shareholder before certain land acquisitions can be made.
- 2 Nelson Airport's constitution sets out the rights and powers of the Kiwi Share and the Kiwi Shareholder.
- 3 The written consent of the Kiwi Shareholder is required before Nelson Airport can enter into any transactions for the acquisition of certain specified land in the vicinity of the airport.
- 4 The written consent of the Kiwi Shareholder is also required for any amendment, removal, or alteration in effect of specified provisions in the constitution. These include the name of the company and clauses specific to the Kiwi Shareholder. In addition, the rights attaching to the Kiwi Share itself are entrenched and cannot be changed without the consent of the Kiwi Shareholder.
- 5 Nelson Airport is the only airport that has a Kiwi Share.

#### We propose that you become the Kiwi Shareholder

- 6 Nelson Airport's constitution provides that any Minister may give written notice to the company of the person who can exercise the rights and powers of the Kiwi Shareholder. At present, the Kiwi Share is not assigned.
- 7 Similar to the long-standing practice that sees the Minister of Transport assigned the rights and responsibilities of the Kiwi Shareholder in Air New Zealand, provided they have no personal shareholding in the airline, we propose that you, in your role as Minister of Transport, take on the role of Kiwi Shareholder in Nelson Airport.

### Next Steps

- 8 If you agree to the proposal, please sign the attached letter to the Prime Minister proposing that you be assigned the responsibility of Kiwi Shareholder.
- 9 If the Prime Minister agrees to the proposal, we have prepared a further letter for your signature. This letter advises Nelson Airport, in accordance with Article 3.1 of the First Schedule to the company's constitution, that you are the person entitled to exercise the rights and powers of the Kiwi Shareholder.
- 10 We will provide you with a briefing if a Nelson Airport land acquisition is proposed requiring your consent, or a specified event occurs that triggers the requirement for the consent of the Kiwi Shareholder.

I have been advised that arrangements need to be made to assign Ministerial responsibility for the Kiwi Share in Nelson Airport Limited.

Nelson Airport's constitution sets out the rights and powers of the Kiwi Share and the Kiwi Shareholder.

The written consent of the Kiwi Shareholder is required before Nelson Airport can enter into any transactions for the acquisition of certain specified land in the vicinity of the airport.

The written consent of the Kiwi Shareholder is also required for any amendment, removal, or alteration in effect of specified provisions in the constitution. These include the name of the company and clauses specific to the Kiwi Shareholder. In addition, the rights attaching to the Kiwi Share itself are entrenched and cannot be changed without the consent of the Kiwi Shareholder.

The Kiwi Share in Nelson Airport Limited is not currently assigned. As ministerial oversight of airports is a function of the Transport portfolio, I recommend that you agree that I, as Minister of Transport, be the person assigned the rights and responsibilities of the Kiwi Shareholder. Accordingly, and if you agree to me undertaking the role of Kiwi Shareholder, I will write to Nelson Airport Limited informing it of the same.

I am advised that Nelson Airport is the only airport that has a Kiwi Share.
