On 20 November 2017, Cabinet:

- noted the advice of the Minister of Transport that he intends, jointly with the Minister of Finance, to send a letter to the Mayor of Auckland to seek his agreement to a proposed process for engagement to refresh the Auckland Transport Alignment Project so that greater priority is attached to public transport and to co-design an urban development strategy for Auckland's growth; and to provide assurance that the government is developing legislation to allow Auckland Council to introduce a regional fuel tax in 2018;
- agreed that, subject to final Cabinet decisions, the government will look to develop legislation that will allow Auckland Council to introduce a regional fuel tax in 2018 of up to 10 cents per litre on petrol and diesel purchased for use on roads, using the 2008 regional fuel tax legislation as a basis.
