



Papanui Parallel Cycleway

A section of the Papanui Parallel, Grants to Tome, where a shared cycling and pedestrian path will provide a direct connection from the local road network at Grassmere Road to the north and Rutland Street to the south. The Papanui Parallel route is a first priority in Christchurch City Council's Major Cycleway programme and extends from Papanui to the CBD.

Benefits: This 'missing link' in the Papanui Parallel will provide a safer option for cyclists currently using this arterial route and will reduce crash risk. On completion of this section an increase in cycling and pedestrian numbers is expected along the whole route.

Total cost estimate: **\$0.75 million**

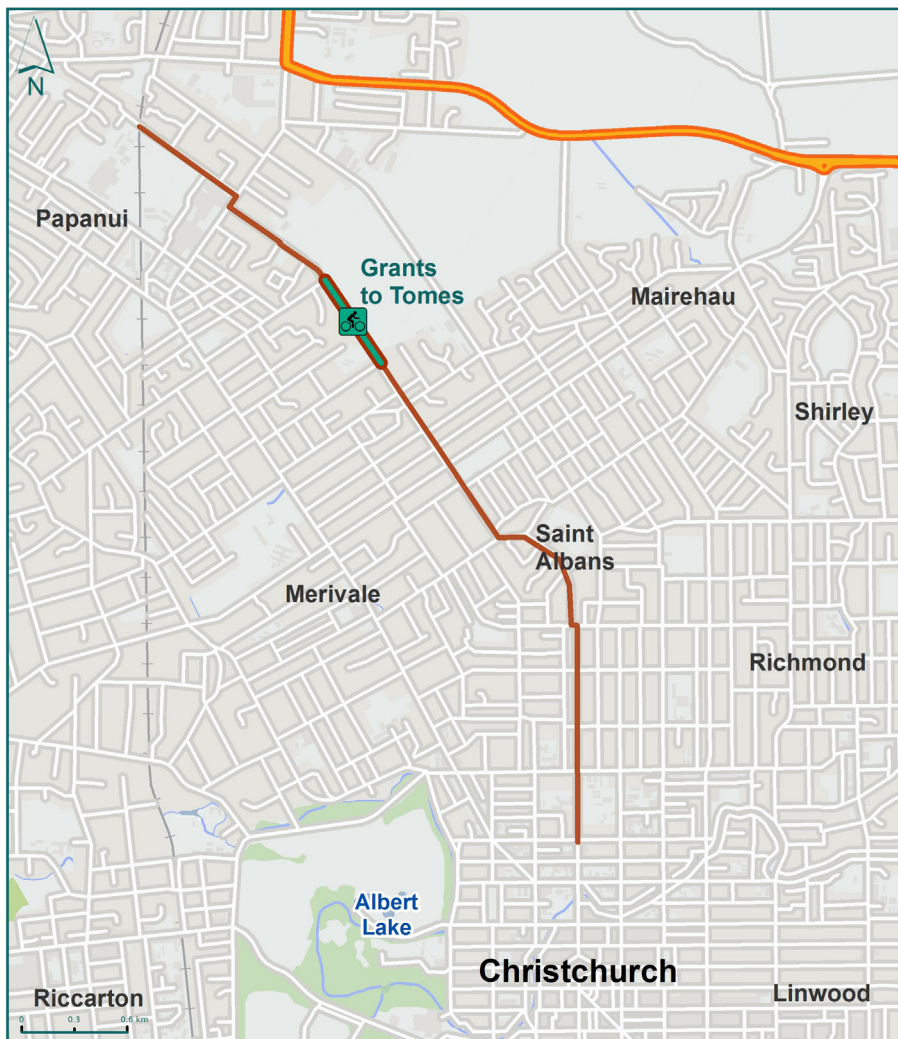

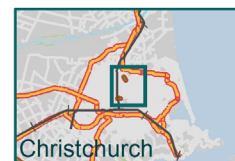
