



Te Awa Cycleway (Hamilton To Ngāruawāhia)

The completion of a primary shared walking and cycling corridor between Hamilton and Ngāruawāhia.

The corridor will enable safe active travel between businesses, schools and residential areas within Hamilton, Horotiu and Ngāruawāhia. It will also provide high quality recreational walking and cycling facilities along the Waikato River.

Benefits: Improving safety on this route will lead to an increase in cycling and walking journeys for transport and leisure. The project also contributes to broader environmental and economic development through promoting tourism and conservation of the Waikato River corridor.

Total cost estimate: **\$4.5 million**

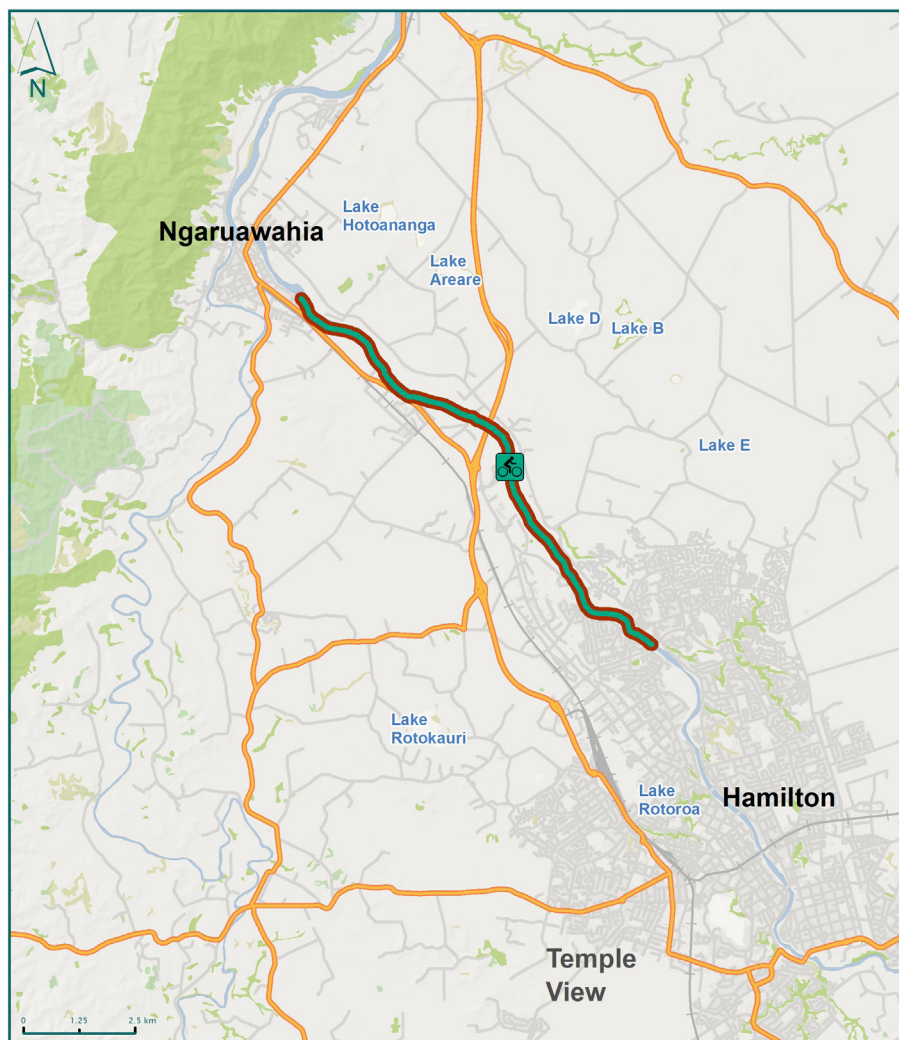

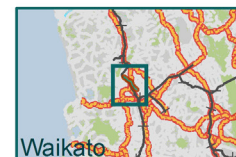
