



Don Buck Road Cycleway

This 700m mixture of on and off-road cycling improvements is the third stage in the Western Journey cycling corridor in Auckland.

The new facilities will extend the existing cycle network from Triangle Road and existing infrastructure on Don Buck Road and will link into other proposed cycling improvements on Red Hills Road and Don Buck Road.

This integrated project is a high priority within the planned cycle network and, together with the Central Park Drive project, will extend a link to the North-western Cycleway and support the Western Ring Route Network Plan.

Benefits: Increased numbers of cyclists using the route by extending existing cycling facilities and providing safer travel through two existing roundabouts on the route.

Total cost estimate: **\$1.26 million**

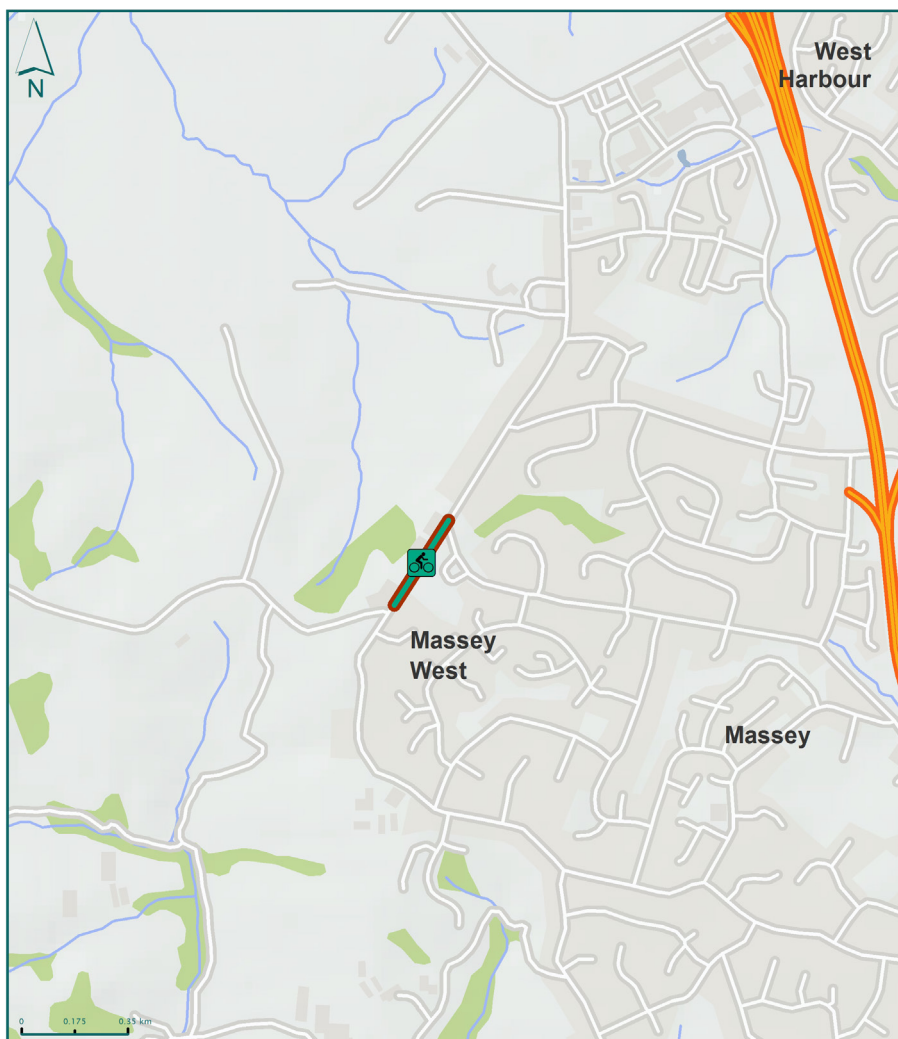

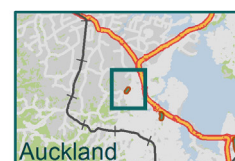
