



Longburn Cycleway

An off-road cycle and pedestrian path alongside a busy state highway corridor linking the Longburn community and commercial area with the rest of Palmerston North.

Benefits: This high speed corridor connects the growing area of Longburn to a local business district, a secondary school and a primary school. This facility will increase transport options for Longburn residents resulting in an increase in cycle journeys to work and school and reduced crash risk.

Total cost estimate: **\$0.9 million**

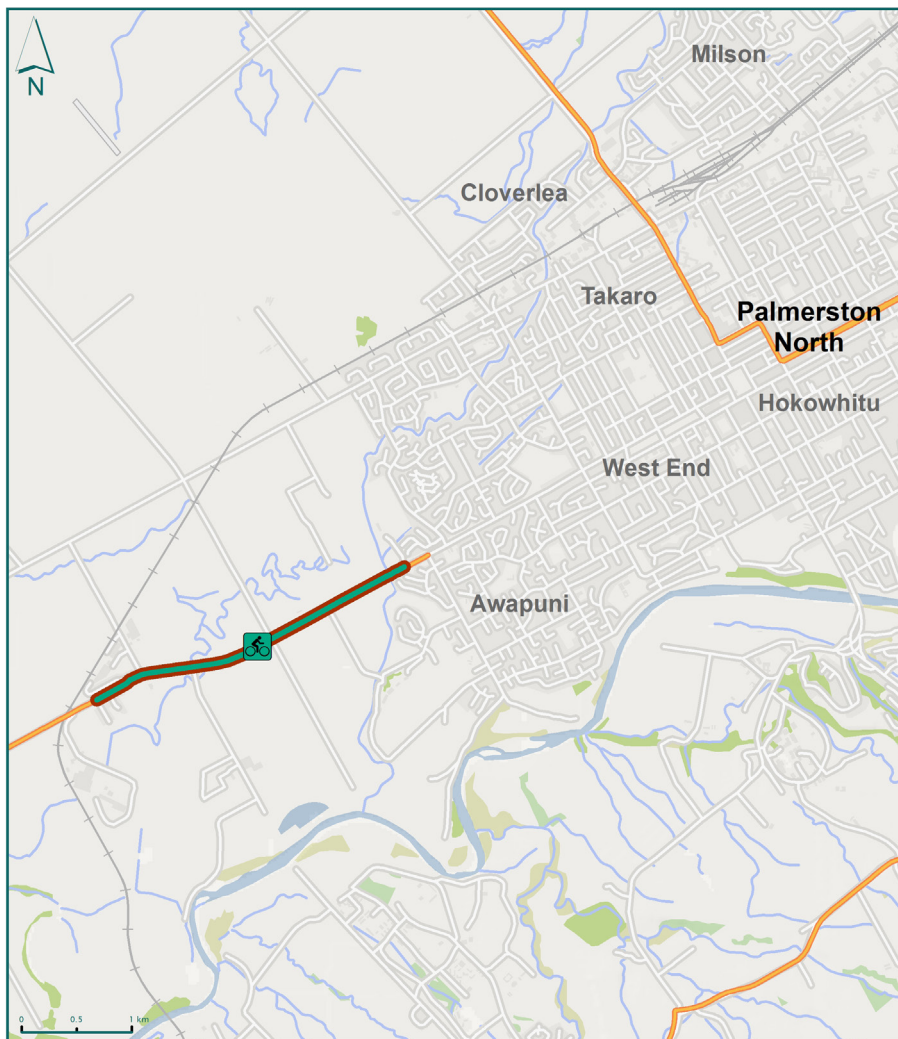

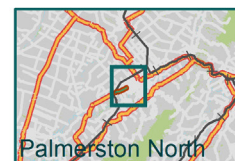
